**2019 SENIOR FINAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE**  
**May 17, 20, 21, 22, 23 2019**

**SENIOR FINAL EXAMINATIONS** are to be one period in length (45 minutes) and cover the subject matter of the **second semester**. They are to count 20% of the 4<sup>TH</sup> quarter grade. Students who miss an exam must see their Dean ASAP to discuss permission for a make-up and then obtain a note from the Dean to be allowed to take the make-up exam.

Seniors who have achieved an average of 85% or higher for the whole year in a subject may be excused from the examination in that particular subject if they have approval and permission of their subject teacher. Seniors who are in the building and who do not have scheduled examinations or are excused from examinations must report to the Cafeteria for a Study Hall. Seniors scheduled in Junior, Sophomore or Freshmen classes are to take examinations in these subjects at the scheduled time and not on an earlier or later date. Sophomores, Juniors and Freshmen in mixed classes will take their examinations during the June Final Examinations. Any senior who has finished his/her examination must remain in the examination room until the end of the exam period.

All books and equipment are to be turned into the subject teachers no later than the last day seniors attend their classes.

The order of periods for all classes is 3-4-1-2-5-6-7. Seniors will be dismissed at the completion of the second exam.

**Wednesday, May 22, 2019**

**PERIOD 5 (7:20- 8:22) & PERIOD 6 (8:26- 9:11) EXAMS**

The order of periods for all classes is 5-6-7-1-2(Lunch)-3-4. Lunch will be during Period 2, the order of which is A, B, and C House. Students in D House will attend 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch. MANDATORY Graduation Rehearsal from 9:15-12:00.

**Make up examinations** will be taken during Period 1 (7:20- 8:22) with teacher arrangements. All seniors (not making up an exam) are to report to the field house for **MANDATORY Graduation Rehearsal** from 8:30-11:30. Seniors will be dismissed upon the successful completion of graduation rehearsal.
